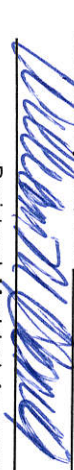

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE GARBAGE DISTRICT

The Garbage Collection District provides for the collection, transportation and delivery of solid waste materials. The Garbage Collection District provides for the collection of designated recyclable materials and used newspapers from curbside, provides pickup and transportation of stock piles of leaves and leaf matter to a composting facility and the payment of garbage tipping fees.

CONTRACTUAL SERVICES

A. F. Basso Jr. Rubbish, Inc.

The contract period is a five-year contract beginning January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2019 for the collection, transportation and delivery of solid waste material. The five-year contract was awarded for \$2,599,500.00.

B. Caputo Brothers Tree Service, Inc.

The contract is a two-year contract for the loading, transportation and disposal of leaves. The two-year contract was awarded for \$5.00 per cubic yard.

C. F. Basso Jr. Rubbish, Inc.

The Contract is a three-year contract beginning January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2017 for curbside collection of recyclable materials. The three-year contract was awarded in the amount of \$369,900.
