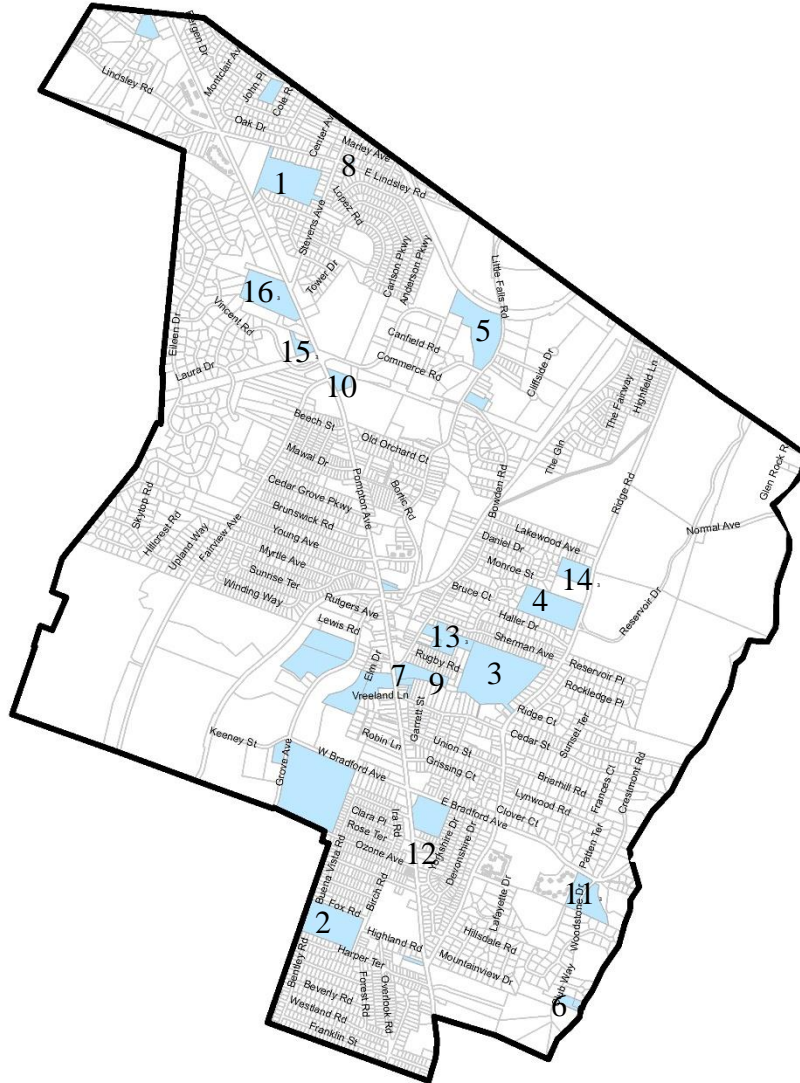


## SECTION 11 - COMMUNITY FACILITIES PLAN ELEMENT

A community's quality of life is greatly influenced by the scope and breadth of public amenities and services afforded to its residents. Educational and library facilities, police, fire and emergency services, public works and administrative services, recreation and open-space facilities are the cornerstones of an educated, healthy, and safe community. The proposed community facilities plan map for the Township of Cedar Grove is noted herein.

As noted in earlier sections of this master plan, the Township of Cedar Grove is considered a fully developed post-World War II suburban community. Cedar Grove's community facilities are in adequate condition and are generally suitable for continued use. Space allocations are generally adequate to serve present population needs. The forecast for the stabilization of population levels requires a greater emphasis on a program of modernization and replacement of out-of-date equipment more than on any expansion of facilities.
