# Existing Land Use

### **SECTION 3 - EXISTING LAND USE**

The analysis of land use is one of the fundamental steps in formulating a plan for the future development of a community. The analysis of existing land use identifies the amount, the location and the relationship of various land uses to one another. Once this data is identified, analysis of physical and environmental constraints affecting the municipality can be prepared to determine the amount and location of developable land in Cedar Grove. This information can then serve as a basis for forecasting future land use, the intensity of use and for the formulation of the land use plan element.

A digital lot-line base map was prepared for the land-use survey. The categories of land use include residential, commercial and office, industrial and three public-use categories as well as separate categories for semi-public uses, streets and roads, and railroads.

#### LAND USE IN CEDAR GROVE


The Township of Cedar Grove has grown from a small rural community of 2,139 people in 1900 to a Township of 12,411 people in 2010. The first half of the twentieth century witnessed a large population increase. A substantial period of growth occurred from 1930 to 1970 as the population more than tripled. The population peaked in 1970 at 15,582 people and decreased to 12,411 people in 2010. Approximately 3.66 percent of Cedar Grove is considered undeveloped.

The development pattern represents a broad array of land uses. Single family development accounts for 1,132.59 acres of land and is the largest land use in the Township. Residential development accounts for approximately 45.19 percent of the land area of Cedar Grove. Parks and open-space uses are the second largest land use in the Township totaling 885 acres of land, or 10.86 percent of the community. Roadways account for the third largest use of land. Public right-of-ways account for 291.86 acres of land or approximately 10.4 percent of the Township. Commercial and office uses total 83.04 acres, or 3.31 percent of the Township. # Census Tract 213 - Block Group 1




Block group 1 in census tract 213 contains approximately 262 tax lots, contains 305.92 acres and represents 10.92 percent of the municipality. Block group 1 is bounded the municipal boundary to the north, to the east along the railroad right of way south to its intersection with Pompton Avenue, to the west along Pompton Avenue to Commerce Road, then north along Village Park, then west to Little Falls Road and then north to municipal boundary. Map 3 – 2: Existing Land Use: Tract 213 Block Group 1 Township of Cedar Grove





Map 3-3: Existing Land Use: Tract 213 Block Group 2 Township of Cedar Grove






Block group 3 in census tract 213 contains approximately 551 tax lots, is 545.28 acres in size and represents 19.47 percent of the municipality. Block group 3 is bounded by the municipal boundary with North Caldwell west, Verona to the south, Little Brook to the north, and Fairview Avenue from the south to its intersection with Pompton Avenue to Montclair Avenue north to the municipal boundary. 

Map 3 - 5: Existing Land Use: Tract 213 Block Group 4 Township of Cedar Grove






Block group 5 in census tract 213 contains approximately 361 tax lots, is 190.08 acres in size and represents 6.78 percent of the municipality. Map 3 - 6: Existing Land Use: Tract 213 Block Group 5 Township of Cedar Grove





Map 3 – 7: Existing Land Use: Tract 214 Block Group 1 Township of Cedar Grove






Block Group 2 in census tract 214 contains approximately 507 tax lots, is 224 acres in size and represents 8.0 percent of the municipality. Block group 2 is bounded Bradford Road to the north, the municipal boundary with Montclair to the West, the municipal boundary with Verona to the South, and Ridge Road (from Bradford to Pompton) the west along Harper, south along Forest, west along Westland then south to the municipal boundary with Verona. 

Map 3-9: Existing Land Use: Tract 214 Block Group 3 Township of Cedar Grove





Map 3 – 10: Existing Land Use: Tract 214 Block Group 4 Township of Cedar Grove






Block group 5 in census tract 214 contains approximately 354 tax lots, is 178.56 acres in size and represents 6.38 percent of the municipality. Block group 5 is bounded by Grove Avenue to the west, Ridge Road to the east, East/West Bradford to the South, and to north by Sherman Road from Ridge to Bowden Road then south to Bowdens intersection with Pompton Avenue and then north to Grove Avenue. Map 3 – 11 : Existing Land Use: Tract 214 Block Group 5 Township of Cedar Grove







# Existing Land Use by Classification Residential Land Use

### Single Family



As noted in Table 3-1, residential development with one to four units per lot is the predominant land use in the community comprising 1,087.09 acres of land representing 43.58 percent of the entire municipality.

# <u>Single Family – Planned Development</u>



As noted in Table 3-1, residential development in a single-family condominium development (Reservoir Ridge) comprising 35.13 acres of land representing 1.41 percent of the entire municipality.

# Multi Family



As noted in Table 3-1, multi-family redevelopment comprising 164.12 acres of land representing 6.58 percent of the entire municipality.

### Newark Watershed



As noted in Table 3-1, four lots comprising 116.23 acres of land representing 4.66 percent of the entire municipality is reserved for the Newark reservoir and watershed.

### **Supportive Housing**



As noted in Table 3-1, supportive housing (nursing homes, rehabilitative housing and senior housing) accounts for 34.11 acres of land or 1.37 percent of the town. These facilities include:

- 1) Arbor Glen Center
- 2) Waterview Center
- 3) Alaris Health at Cedar Grove
- 4) St. Vincent's Health Care and Rehab Center
- 5) Cedar Grove Senior Citizen apartments

### Commercial & Office Land Use



Commercial and office land uses are concentrated along Route 23 (Pompton Avenue). As noted in Table 3-1, commercial land uses account for 88.79 acres of land or 3.56 percent of the town.

### **Industrial Land Use**



Industrial land uses are mainly found on in four different areas of the municipality. The firs area, in the northern central portion of town can be found along Commerce Road, Village Park, Canfield, and Sand Park Roads. The second area is just north and east on Little Falls and Old Bridge Roads and Cliffside Drive. The two smaller areas can be found along Pompton Avenue and Rugters Avenue and Lewis Road. As noted in Table 3-1, commercial land uses account for 135.90 acres of land or 5.45 percent of the town.

### **Public Land Uses**



Lands that are publicly owned and committed to specific uses total more than 134 acres of land.

This category represents lands that are owned and utilized for municipal uses including detention basins, water tanks and the Department of Public Works and the Municipal complex. These lands

### Parkland



There are three different types of parkland represented in this category, 1) County Owned Parkland 2) Municipal Owned Parkland and 3) Private recreational land. This land use contains 885 acres of land representing 10.86 percent of the municipality.

### Schools



There are two public lower schools, one middle school and one high school. There are two private school facilities and a number of private pre-kindergarten facilities. The public schools occupying a total of 62.85 acres of land. The schools are:

- 3) Memorial Middle School
- 4) Cedar Grove High School

### Houses of Worship

There are seven Houses of Worship within the Township of Cedar Grove offering residents religious facilities of many faiths. These seven houses of worship occupies 41.98 acres of land and consist of the following:

### Streets and Roads



There are a total of 291.86 acres of land that are devoted to streets and roads in the Township of Cedar Grove. This represents 10.4 percent of the area of the Township. Route 23 is under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey State Department of Transportation. Fairview, Grove, Bradford, and Stevens Avenues, Reservoir Drive, and Ridge, Little Falls, and Lindsley Roads are under the jurisdiction of Essex County. All other roadways are under the jurisdiction of the Township of Cedar Grove.

### Vacant Lands



There are a total of 60 vacant tax lots, 80.31 acres of vacant land in Cedar Grove representing 3.22 percent of the community.

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
