

## COVID-19 Pool Operation Prevention Plan

1. Staffing and Pool Facility Operations
  - a. Staff will be trained on COVID-19 awareness, cleaning and sanitizing to ensure the safety of the patrons and staff. Their mandatory training in COVID-19 awareness and risk reduction strategies will be held on May 18, 2021. Staff will not be permitted to work unless they receive this training.
  - b. A COVID ambassador will be assigned to monitor that pool patrons and staff are following all protocols put in place.
  - c. All staff shall be screened and temperature checked, each shift upon entering the pool facility.

2. Admittance and access to the Pool Facility
  - a. Appropriate signage will be posted at entry points with reminders about face-coverings, staying socially distanced and reminding patrons to stay home if feeling ill.
  - b. Patron attendance will be maintained to facilitate the contact tracing efforts.
  - c. The emergency evacuation procedure will include social distancing protocol.
  
3. The Township will implement the following prevention strategies to limit the COVID-19 exposure and spread;
  - a. We will cooperate with the local Health Department in any disease investigation.
  - b. Enhanced cleaning and disinfections procedures shall be used several times each day in high traffic areas such as benches, bathrooms, changing rooms, as well as the end of each day.
  - c. There will be no lounge chairs provided for shared use.
  - d. Sanitizing station will be provided within the facility.
  - e. Frequent sanitization of lifeguard stands, lifesaving equipment, railings and 1<sup>st</sup> Aid room shall be performed as needed.
  - f. Restroom showers will be closed to the public.
