Pool will open weekends only beginning on Saturday May 29th. The pool is open full time from June 19th through September 6th. **Pool Hours: Weekdays: 12:00–7:00pm. Saturdays & Holidays: 11:00am-7:00pm and Sundays: 10:00am-6:00pm.**

***Pool Hours will change in August when lighting prohibits swimming.**

***The pool will close at 5:00pm on Tuesday, August 3rd for Cedar Grove Night Out. (This is subject to change)**

Daily Pool Guest Fee

Pool Membership

Pool membership consists of; Township residents, full-time municipal employees, Board of Education employees and a limited number of Non-Resident members.

Payment

Payments may be made by check or money order, made payable to Township of Cedar Grove. There are no refunds after May 28th, 2021. All membership applications are to be mailed or dropped off to: Cedar Grove Recreation, 525 Pompton Ave. Cedar Grove NJ, 07009. There will be a box located on table in Town Hall Lobby for Pool Membership Only. Please be sure to have everything in a sealed envelope.

Family Membership – NEW INFORMATION INCLUDED

Family Membership includes; A family of husband and wife/civil union couple and their unmarried children residing in the same household. **Any other person(s) that live in the household must submit proof of ID with matching address with their registration and will pay an additional \$100/adult and \$75/child.** This membership does not apply to any person(s) visiting for the summer. You must bring the (visiting) person(s) as a guest (if permitted at some point in the summer) or pay for an out-of-town family membership.

Seniors

A senior is any person 62 years old and older.

***FOR PAAD ONLY:** To be eligible for a discounted senior citizen rate, applicant must also qualify for PAAD (Pharmaceutical Assistance to the Aged and Disability). **This does not include Medicaid or Medicare. You must submit up to date PAAD cards for discount.**

Married Couple/Civil Union or Parent/Child

Covers two adults with no children OR one parent with one child.

Individuals

Individual memberships are available for ages 18 and above.

Babysitter

Additional badge that can be purchased. Babysitter only permitted in while accompanying children. This badge is only valid Monday-Friday.

Guests

Beginning the weekend of June 5, 2021, the Cedar Grove Pool will now allow guests. A guest MUST be accompanied by a Cedar Grove Pool Member that is 18 years or older for the duration of their visit. An adult is anyone 18 yrs. and older. Guest 2 years old and younger will not be charged.

Early Bird Swim

Early Bird Swim is for Adult Members Only on Mondays through Thursdays starting June 21st and ending August 19th 7:00-9:00 am.

Badges

Different colored badges will be issued to each member. Everyone is expected to display their badge to gain entrance to the pool. **BADGE PICK-UP DATES 2021** from 4:30-7:30PM on the following dates; Monday April 12th, Wednesday May 12th & Friday May 28th at the Cedar Grove Pool Front Doors. You must have a badge to enter the pool, regardless of paid membership. **Anyone transferring badges will lose their membership immediately.** Lost badges should be reported to Recreation Dept. **A replacement badge will be issued by the Recreation Department for a \$30.00 fee.** Please pick-up badges prior to pool opening.

Adult Swim

Adult Swim is a 20-minute period set aside for swimmers 18 years old and older (at manager's discretion). For safety reasons, those with infants must remain in the shallow end of pool, south of the rope.

Swim Lessons – ALL SWIM LESSON CLASSES ARE LIMITED

Group Swim Lessons are offered at the Cedar Grove Pool for a fee of \$20.00/child for pool members.

Non-pool members are eligible to join starting on May 21st for a fee of \$100.00/child.

We will also hold Parent & Me Lessons for the same pricing.

Eligibility for swim lessons; Children must be 4 years old by the start of lessons, and be able to stand at the shallow end of pool (3.5 ft. depth) with their heads above the water.

Eligibility for Parent & Me; Children must be 2 years old by the start of the lessons.

Payment;

-SWIM LESSON REGISTRATION FORM AND PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED THE SAME TIME AS POOL APPLICATION.

-Separate check needed. Please do not put swim lessons on the same check as pool membership.

-Checks made payable to Township of Cedar Grove.

Diapered Children

According to N.J.A.C 8:2-5.4, all children in diapers **MUST** wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands when entering pool. Plastic pants will be available for purchase through a Pool Manager.

**TOWNSHIP OF CEDAR GROVE
COMMUNITY POOL
RULES 2021**

1. All patrons are required to check-in and out each day upon entry for contact tracing purposes.
2. Social distancing of 6 feet is required between patrons who are not family is encouraged.
3. There will be **NO LOUNGE CHAIRS** provided this summer. You will have to bring your own pool chair if you wish to sit on the pool deck and take home with you each day.
4. The Pool Manager has the right to close the pool at any time due to prevailing light, weather, or any other conditions that would affect the safety of our members.
5. Pool Memberships are limited to Township Residents, Full time Municipal Employees, Board of Education employees and a limited number of Non-Residents.
6. No child under the age of 18 years will be allowed to join pool as an Individual. No child under the age of 13 will be permitted to enter the pool unless accompanied by a pool member 18 years of age or older, who shall remain with the child the duration of the pool visit.
7. Adult Swim: During Adult Swims (18 or older), parents holding infants must remain in shallow end of pool, south of rope for safety reasons. Adult Swims will last 20 minutes at manager's discretion.
8. The Pool Manager will have the authority to suspend any member or guest of their pool privileges who; destroy property/equipment or violates any of the Rules and Regulations. The Pool Manager shall be responsible for the enforcement of all rules and regulations, and any other situations that might endanger the welfare of those on the premises.
9. The use of the Wading Pool (Baby Pool) shall be limited to children up to 6 years of age. Children capable of swimming in the adult pool do not belong in the Wading Pool, especially during Adult Swims. Lifeguards are stationed in the area for safety and first aid purposes, and are not expected to provide child care. At no time shall a child be left unattended.
10. According to N.J.A.C 8:2-5.4, all children in diapers **MUST** wear plastic pants with snug fitting elastic waist and leg bands when entering pool. Plastic pants will be available for purchase through a Pool Manager.
11. Small individual floats are allowed in the Wading Pool (baby pool) only. Toys, rubber balls, inner tubes, snorkels, life vests, etc. are permitted in the Wading Pool, but are not allowed in the Adult Pool.
12. Food shall be eaten in the designated Snack Bar area **ONLY**. Food shall not be eaten on pool deck. Face coverings are to be worn until seated and eating.
13. Smoking is prohibited in the entire pool and park complex. This includes e-cigarettes, vapes and all other substitute tobacco products as well.
14. Diving is permitted from diving boards only. No swimming is permitted in the area of the diving board. All dives must be perpendicular from point of takeoff. No jumping in at the shallow end. **NO DOUBLE BOUNCING ON THE DIVING BOARDS.**

15. Parents holding infants **MUST** remain in the shallow end of pool, south of the rope.
16. Management may close the pool or remove a patron, whenever the safety or health of the membership is endangered and may prohibit any action or conduct which is dangerous, improper, illicit or immoral.
17. No loitering in the vicinity of Lifeguard stands, pool entrance ladders or stairs.
18. All patrons within the pool area must be attired in appropriate swim apparel (no thongs permitted).
19. Lifeguards will give a signal to get out of water if there is an emergency. Anyone not adhering to the signal will be asked to leave premises.
20. Dogs and other pets are prohibited on pool grounds.
21. No wrestling, horseplay, punching, fighting allowed on pool grounds or in pool. No pushing or pulling others into the pool. **Lifeguards and Management reserve all rights to bench and warn patrons for any of the offenses listed.** If there are multiple warnings given, this can result in membership removal.
22. Running is not permitted in pool area.
23. No loud radios or recording devices are permitted.
24. Alcohol, glass containers and gambling is not permitted in the pool area. **Anyone entering pool grounds with cooler must be inspected at front door prior to entering.**
25. Spitting, littering and foul language is prohibited.
26. **Individuals who disobey pool rules will be benched by Lifeguards/Pool Manager, based on the severity of offense. Written Incident Reports will be kept on file in Guard Office. The Pool Manager has the right to suspend anyone violating rules and regulations.**
