1. ROLL CALL – OPEN PUBLIC MEETING STATEMENT BY MAYOR

TOWNSHIP MANAGER – The Manager provided a memo from the Municipal Engineer that recommended rejection of the bid for furnishing equipment & personnel for snow removal, to which the governing body agreed. 5. TOWNSHIP CLERK – The Clerk provided additional information regarding proposed amendments to OPMA and OPRA legislation. There was consensus to discuss at the next staff meeting.

Councilwoman Peterson provided an update of architects' review of library space. Councilwoman Peterson stated that the role of the public library has expanded to serve as a community center for various age groups. Councilwoman Peterson advised that in order to obtain some input and entice the teen segment of the population to frequent the Library, a "Teen Night" is being planned to take place prior to the tree lighting ceremony. During further discussion, the Township Manager explained that the Library is subject to Local Public Contracts Law.

The following resolution had been posted on the bulletin board, and a brief synopsis was given by the Township Clerk: **WHEREAS,** N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87, provides that the Director of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of a special item of revenue in the Municipal Budget of the Township of Cedar Grove for 2017 when such items shall have been available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation of equal amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Cedar Grove, Essex County, New Jersey, that it hereby requests that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insert of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2017 in the sum of \$2,990.70, which is now available as a revenue from the Body Armor Replacement Fund Program, which is administered by the Division of Criminal Justice, pursuant to the provision of statute; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a like sum of \$2,990.70 is hereby appropriated under the caption:

Body Armor Replacement Fund Program \$2,990.70

c) To consider resolution reduction of performance bond – Grove Street SPE, LLC

WHEREAS, Grove Street SPE, LLC received preliminary and final site plan approval for Block 71, Lot 2, from the Zoning Board; and

WHEREAS, a developer's agreement was approved by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Cedar Grove on April 6, 2015; and

WHEREAS, sureties were posted to guarantee construction of site improvements consistent with the Zoning Board approval of the project; and

WHEREAS, a performance bond (First Indemnity of America Insurance Co. Bond No. CT021007) was posted by Grove Street SPE, LLC on June 12, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Grove Street SPE, LLC has requested release of certain sureties; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer has inspected said premises to consider reduction/release of said sureties; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer has recommended reduction of the existing performance bond only.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Cedar Grove that it does hereby approve the reduction of Performance Bond No. CT021007 from \$864,304.20 to \$454,597.20

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy to this resolution be forwarded to the Essex County Division of Housing & Community Development.
