Part of the historic mission of public education has been to teach students the importance of their identity as citizens of the United States of America, including the rights and responsibilities that come with living in a democracy. Voting is both a fundamental right and a primary responsibility of citizenship, and is part of the system of checks and balances in our government that guarantee both our liberty and our security. Unfortunately, the voter turnout levels in the United States are continuing to decline, with young people the least likely to show up at the polls on Election Day.

A new law in New Jersey is designated to directly engage 16-18 year old high school students in the voting process in the very best way possible: by allowing them to be trained and available to serve as election board (poll) workers.

Election board workers are the citizens that administer the polling places on election day. For example, assisting voters at the sign-in table, in some districts – interpreting for Bi-lingual voters, and assisting voters with any aspect of the voting process. A student serving at the polls engages them in the election process, and allows young people to understand the importance of participation in the political process. The law requires that permission be granted by student's school, and by student's parent or guardian. (attached)

Prior to serving, a two hour training session will be conducted by the Essex County Board of Elections. The student must complete the training program before being eligible to serve on election day.

He/she may be assigned at the discretion of the County Board of Elections to assist at the polls in upcoming elections. Minors between 16-18 years of age may serve at an election between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on a day that the election is held. Transportation for students to and from the polls is the responsibility of the student/parent and cannot be provided by county election offices.
