- Major Tree – Greater than 6 inches in Diameter.
- Minor Tree – Between 4-inches and 6-inches in Diameter.

Planting of New Tree:

- Major Tree – 2½ inch – 3 inch caliper, deciduous.
- Minor Tree – Evergreen or Ornamental Tree, 6 ft. minimum height.

* Note: 2 minor trees can be planted in place of 1 major tree if more suitable to lot conditions as determined by the Engineer.
